

## The Blood Protecting Against The Destroyer

Exodus 12: 21-23 relates the story of the killing of the lamb and of sprinkling the blood on the lintel and the doorposts. In the middle of the night, the destroyer will pass and strike the first born son, of humans and animals, in every household that was not sprinkled with blood. Only the blood, not good works or prayers, saves from death.

**You will not escape eternal destruction by your works or by being religious, but by taking refuge in the blood of the Lord Jesus. Did you put your trust in this precious blood to escape eternal destruction?**

**Exodus 12: 22, “And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin.”**

The hyssop is a plant of no value. It talks about my weakness; meaning that the blood was shed for the weak. Confess out loud : I am weak like this plant, but strong and protected because of this blood. The destroyer cannot harm me. Say to Satan: I am strong because I am dipped in the blood. **“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb” (Rev. 12: 11)**

This plant speaks to us also about the cleansing stated in the law of the leper. Psalm 51: 7 “Purge me with the hyssop, and I shall be clean.” When the house was sprinkled by the blood, it appeared clean in the eyes of the Lord. The Lord sees the blood – and the blood covers sin. This is the meaning of cleansing. The blood of Jesus “cleanse(s) us from all unrighteousness”

***When you believe in the blood of Jesus, you become clean before God!!***

- Balaam, the Old Testament sorcerer, was unable to affect the people of God by his witchcraft, because of the altar and the sacrifices which point to the blood of the Lord Jesus and the cross. The heavenly Father sees the blood of his precious Son in these sacrifices, that’s why **“He has not observed iniquity in Jacob, nor has He seen wickedness in Israel” (Numbers 23: 21)** Witchcraft cannot affect you since you are protected by the Blood

In pronouncing blessing over the forgiven man, **“Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit” (Ps. 32: 1, 2).** David is speaking about himself; for he sinned (committed adultery) but enjoyed salvation and cleansing by the blood.

You should always from the destroyer by the blood. Moses told them **“and none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning.”**

Do not depend on your own understanding; so that the evil spirits that occupy the atmosphere around us and witchcraft do not affect you. The blood of Jesus has to be your barrier to be protected from Satan.

This destroyer will not enter and harm me or my possessions as he did the homes of the Egyptians and killed their first born. My safety comes from my confession that the precious blood will protect me from all harm.
